STEM is happening all around RLS this week! Kindergarten students are developing their creativity as they use materials such as magnetiles, strawbees and “snowflakes” in their STEM bins. Junior Kindergarten made snowmen outside with special materials and have discussed how snowflakes are formed. Fourth graders have been learning about “wild hearts”. Did you know that giraffe hearts are 2 feet long? They discussed the fact that human hearts are not “heart” shaped. They worked in collaborative groups to create a tower out of Valentine candy.
