Summer Reading Assignment:

During the summer please read the following novel. You should be ready to discuss the novel in your classes in the Fall. We have class sets of each of the following and all current students who requested a copy were given one before they left for the summer.

Rising 6th Grade: *Wonder* by RJ Palacio

Rising 7th Grade: *Wednesday Wars* by Gary D. Schmidt

Rising 8th Grade: *Restart* by Gordon Korman

Summer Math Review Assignment:

To keep your math skills in tip-top shape, the summer assignment is to complete a minimum of 240 minutes in math on IXL. **You will have from Saturday, May 23rd until midnight on Friday, August 7th to complete the assignment.**

Our suggestion is you work a little each week (10 minutes a day, 3 days a week, for 8 weeks equals 240 minutes) to help you review and prepare you for the upcoming year. However, if you prefer, you can complete it all in one day, over a weekend, or during the last week of summer...that's up to you. Successful completion of 240 minutes in math will result in a first quarter quiz grade of 100. If the minimum requirement is not reached, the quiz grade will be a zero.
